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REQUIREMENTS FOR THESES FORMATTING

The theses of the report are submitted in the Microsoft Word editor (Times New Roman, size – 14, line spacing – 1.5, paragraph indent – 1 cm, all margins – 2 cm) in .doc format without hyphens in words. The surname and initials are typed in the right upper corner. The title of the theses is put in capital letters, in bold, with center alignment symmetrically to the text. The main text is put one line after the title. The sources cited in the References should be given in the alphabetical order; references in the text should be made in square brackets, indicating the source number and page: [1, p. 45].

INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

I. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMATTING THE ARTICLE:

1. Articles are submitted only in the electronic version (pedagogy@mdpu.org.ua) or uploaded directly through the OJS interface (<http://ojs.mdpu.org.ua/index.php/nv>).
2. Language of the article: Ukrainian, English.
3. The volume of the article is from **0.4** (16,000) to **1 printer's sheet**. (40,000 printed characters including spaces). (Menu – Service – Statistics). The optimal volume of the article is 0.5 printer's sheet.
4. The text must be typed in the text editor MS Word.
5. Page parameters: all margins – 2.5 cm, without headers and page numbering. The paper size – A4.
6. The font of the main text is Times New Roman, size 12, normal style. The text is printed without hyphens.
7. Paragraph parameters:
 - alignment – by width;
 - line spacing – 1;
 - paragraph indent – 1 cm.
 - interval between paragraphs – 0 mm.

II. PUBLISHING DESIGN OF STRUCTURAL ELEMENTS
TEXT OF THE ARTICLE:

Block 1. UDC index (12 pt., in the left corner, bold font, without indent of the first line);

Block 2 – in Ukrainian:

- **title of the article** (12 pt., centered, bold font, capital letters, paragraph without indent of the first line);
- Full name of the author (in full, 12 pt., regular, centered);
- *the name of the institution where the author works (in full, 12 pt, centered, italics)*;
- **Abstract:** (12 pt., italics, bold). On the next line – the abstract text with a volume of 600 to 800 printed characters (12 pt., regular, justified);
- **Keywords:** (12 pt., bold). Next, in the same line – a list of keywords from 3 to 8 terms, separated by a semicolon ";" (12 pt., regular, justified).

Block 3 – in English:

- **Resume:** (12 pt., bold).
- **Full name of the author** (from a new line, in full, 12 pt., justified);
- **the title of the article** (12 pt., bold font, immediately after the full name of the

author in the same line, in small letters). Next, from a new line – the text of the annotation with a volume of 1500 to 2000 printed characters (12 pt., regular, justified);

- **Keywords:** (12 pt., bold). Next, in the same line – a list of keywords from 3 to 8 terms, separated by a semicolon ";" (12 pt., regular).

Block 4 The main text of the article (12 pt., regular font) should include the following elements approved by the resolution of the Presidium of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine No. 7-06/1 dated January 15, 2003. “On increasing the requirements for professional publications included in the list of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine.”:

- statement of the problem in general terms and its connection to significant scientific or practical tasks.
- analysis of the latest research and publications in which the solution to the raised problem is initiated, and on which the author relies;
- formulation of the article's goals (task setting);
- presentation of the main material of the research with a full justification of the obtained scientific results;
- research conclusions and prospects for further work in this direction.

Block 5. References (in the original language):

- subtitle “References” (separate paragraph, 12 pt., semi-bold font, capital letters, centered);
- references (12 pt., regular font) is presented in alphabetical order, drawn up according to DSTU GOST 7.1:2006.
- refer to the source in the text in round brackets (Ashitok, 2015, p. 4), where the author, year of publication and page number are indicated.

Block 6. References (in English):

- subtitle "References" (separate paragraph, 12 pt., bold font, capital letters, centered);
- references in accordance with the requirements of APA style, 6th edition:

Block 7. Brief information about the author(s) in Ukrainian and English languages: last name, first name, patronymic – academic degree, academic title, position, e-mail; name of the institution of higher education, legal address of the institution.

III. FORMATTING OF INDIVIDUAL OBJECTS:

3.1.1. Lists

Lists are drawn up as follows:

- numbered: “1. “, “1) “, “a“;
- marked: “- “, “•”.

3.1.2. Tables

Tables are numbered. The word “*Table 1.*” is given in italics in the right corner. **Table name** format: centered title, boldface, placement above the table. You must omit one line after the table. One line must be omitted after the table.

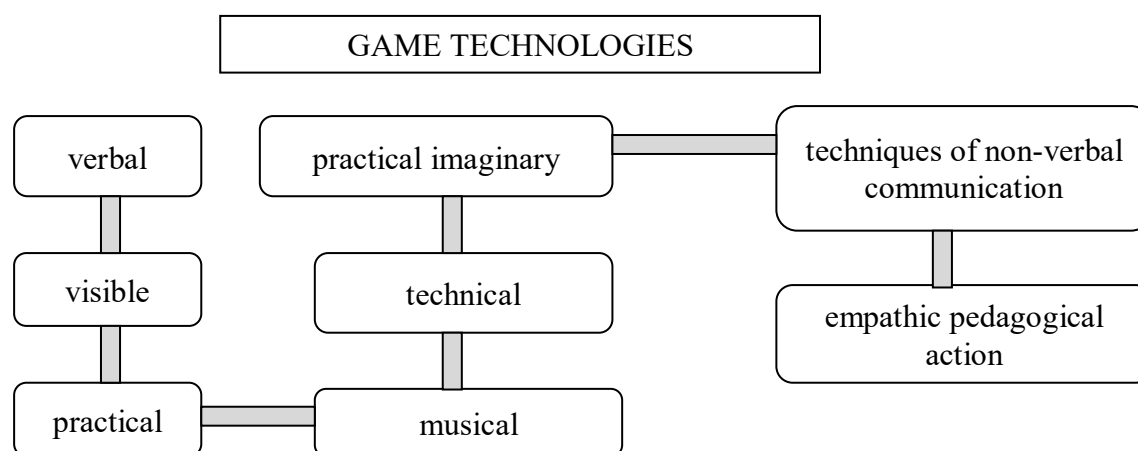


Fig. 1. Game technologies
